22003 – The Positive Pay export option has been modified to accept a date range. This will allow positive pay export to show for just one day or any date range desired. This is found under File > Export Utility.

22004 – Microsoft 365 recently made to change to not allow TLS 1.0 or 1.1 to be used when emailing. The default TLS Promas uses is the system’s default, which for some computers was TLS 1.0 or 1.1. The installer now includes an override to force TLS 1.2 to be used to allow Microsoft 365 customers to email from Promas.

22005 – The ability to delete letters has been added. From Mailings > Edit Letters > Edit a letter > Click Delete. Letters assigned to notices (Setup > Notices) cannot be deleted until the reference is removed.
